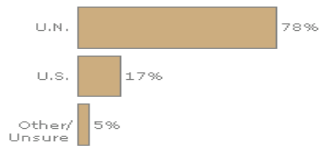

Purpose:

The student will understand the value of public opinion. The student will also be able to find differences between liberal and conservative group will research the history and presidency of selected Presidents. The group will gain insight of the men who have served as President

Procedure:
