



US/AZ Government President Editorial Project

Purpose:

The student will use the internet to research how the President of the United States is viewed in other countries. The students will also see how the First Amendment works in other countries.

Materials:

Internet

Vocabulary:

President
Editorial
Political Cartoon
Free Speech

Procedure:

1. Find three editorials from three different countries, on three different continents that discuss the President or a policy of the President's. Summarize each editorial. Do not cut and paste from the editorial, use your own words.
2. Find three political cartoons from three other countries. These three countries need to be different than the three selected in question 1. The cartoons need to portray the President. The cartoons may be on any topic as long as the President is in the cartoon. Summarize each cartoon. You will need to print out the cartoon.
3. Analyze how the President is portrayed. Is the President popular? Is he well received in certain countries, but not others? Is there any general feelings that you can gather about the President?

Product:

The final product will include a summary of each editorial and cartoon and an analysis of how other countries view the President.
