

The purpose of Academic Lab is to provide students with a setting where a teacher can provide assistance and monitor academic achievement. Academic Lab provides a framework where students can seek assistance with assignments, make up tests, and complete other assigned work.

To ensure that all of that occurs on a daily basis, here are a few guidelines for Academic Lab:

US/AZ Government Academic Lab is for World History. Do not come to lab to work on another class. This includes asking other people that are not in Government to meet you in lab.

Academic lab is a short time period, Unit Exams take all 94 minutes to complete. Use lab to make up reading quizzes and chapter tests.

Come to lab prepared. Know what you want from lab. If you have questions on the readings, be sure to bring your readings with you. If you have questions regarding outlines, bring them with along. If you need to make a quiz or short test, let me know before lab starts, so your assessment materials will be ready for you. This gives you the maximum amount time for the assessment. You will not be allowed to leave lab once you have entered to retrieve any materials.

You must have your Academic Lab pass to enter lab. If you do not have a pass, you will not be allowed into lab.

You must sign in when you enter lab. The sign in book is in the front of the classroom.

You will be expected to work in Academic Lab. This is not a time to socialize. There will be other students who are there to increase their academic achievement. Be considerate of others.
